Finding the office

When you have reached the office, please use the intercom on the first door, nearest the road, to let us know you have arrived.

By Car - from M4 (South)

Leave M4 Motorway at Junction 11 and follow the A33 (signposted for Reading Station). At the end of the A33, keep left and follow the road straight on, towards Caversham and the station, as it becomes the A329. Then keep right to stay on the (A329), ignoring the slip roads. After passing underneath the railway bridge, take the next left into Northfield Road. Coffey's office is immediately on the left, behind the large blue gates.

By Car - from M40 (North)

Leave M40 at Junction 6 and follow signs to Reading, through Watlington, Nettlebed and Sonning Common. Enter Reading via B481 Peppard Road. Continue until you reach traffic lights and turn right onto A4155/Prospect Street. Take the 2nd exit at the roundabout onto Church Street and continue over Caversham bridge. Take the 2nd exit at the roundabout and continue along the road, taking the 3rd right, Swansea Road. After approx 200m, turn left down Northfield Road. The office is located on the right with a car park behind through blue gates.

By Train

Reading station can be accessed via overground (GWR) and Elizabeth Line services.

If exiting Reading station from the south, turn immediately right and down the steps/ramp, away from the town centre. Walk along Station Hill and continue as it becomes Tudor Road. Turn right and follow the footpath under the railway bridge. Walk along Caversham Road, cross the road at the pedestrian crossing and take the first left into Northfield Road

If exiting Reading station from the north, continue straight on out of the Station, along Trooper Potts Way and then turn left at the traffic lights, onto Vastern Road. Walk past the "Station

Shopping Park” (containing Aldi and The Range) then turn left after TGI Friday’s on the roundabout. Cross the road at the pedestrian crossing and turn right and then immediately left onto Northfield Road. Coffey’s office is immediately on the left, behind the large blue gates.

By Air

London Heathrow Airport is the closest international airport. Reading can be accessed from Heathrow by London Underground (Elizabeth line to Reading, changing at Hayes & Harlington), by the Reading RailAir coach, which drops off at Reading station south entrance, or by car.
